Report on a One-Week State-Level Online Faculty Sensitization & Development Program on the "Recent NBA Accreditation Process for TIER-II Technical Institutions" (30-11-2022 to 05-12-2022)

Introduction

The One-Week State-Level Online Faculty Sensitization & Development Program on the Recent NBA Accreditation Process for TIER-II Technical Institutions was organized by GGSES Technical Campus in collaboration with Jharkhand University of Technology.
